Between 8 and 11 volunteers have turned up to help on every occasion for a couple of hours hard work, all 'doing their bit' for the community. We have now finished our winter programme, because sap is beginning to rise in the trees and it is bird-nesting season. Work will resume in the late autumn or winter, when we may have some hedging to plant and, no doubt by then, other projects added to the work list.
